

Attention Visitors!

Visitation is permitted on specific units between 1pm and 6pm for NON-COVID patients only.

Please adhere to the following visitation guidelines. Any visitor showing signs of illness will be asked to leave immediately:

- ➤ Adult Medical/Surgical Units: Two people can visit at each visitation time.
- ➤ Medical ICU: One person can visit at a time during designated visiting hours.
- Surgical ICU: One person can visit at a time during designated visiting hours.
- > Coronary ICU: One person can visit at a time during designated visiting hours.
- Pediatric units: Two designated support persons with patient.
- ➤ Maternity and Labor Delivery units: Two support persons, including doula may accompany patient.
- ➤ Neonatal Intensive Care Units: Two parent/support persons can visit.
- > ED and Outpatients areas: Visitors in special situations.
- Ambulatory Surgery & Same Day Surgery: Pediatric patients are to be accompanied by one parent or guardian. Adult patients may have accompaniment in certain situations.
- > Behavioral Health Unit: Please call the unit for visiting hours

Please Note: Extenuating circumstances (Hospice) will be considered based on the best interest and needs of individual patients

All visitors must remain in patient's room and adhere to hand hygiene and proper mask/PPE protocols.
